Jane Greengold Stevens is co-director of the special litigation unit at New York Legal Assistance Group in New York City. She has worked in legal aid for most of her 50-year legal career, starting at Legal Assistance Foundation of Chicago in 1969. In her many years of practice, she has been a passionate champion for the rights of low-income consumers. She has an impressive

track record of successful litigation, including cases against predatory for-profit schools who defrauded their students. Jane has brought cases against the state and federal governments on behalf of student loan borrowers, including the successful 1994 case *Gibbons v. Riley*, which benefitted 3 million student loan borrowers. She has also attacked unlawful debt collection practices and protected exempt income from seizure in consumers' bank accounts.
