This matter was heard by me on Monday, August 20, 1984, at 10:00 o'clock A.M. at the Charleston County Courthouse. The trial on the merits was had as to Defendants. Victor Barker and EconoTouristic Associates, Inc. and a hearing to determine damages was held as to the Defendant Jet Charter, Inc. which had previously been held to be in default. Representing Defendants Victor Barker and EconoTouristic Associates, Inc. was Paul Uricchio, Jr. of the Charleston Bar. Representing the State was Assistant Attorney General C. Richard Kelly. No one appeared to represent the Defendant Jet Charter, Inc.

The State put into evidence a check from EconoTouristic Associates, Inc. to Jet Charter for \$5,000 as payment on a contract between these two companies for a flight which was

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to leave Charleston March 26, 1983. The State put into evidence without objection the depositions of various witnesses to the facts of this case. It is clear from this evidence that the trip scheduled for March 26, 1983, was cancelled. There is no evidence that Jet Charter, Inc. incurred any expenses as to that trip. Therefore, I find that the \$5,000 deposit which was paid to Jet Charter, Inc. for the trip should be paid over to the State to be used to repay those persons who had paid EconoTouristic Associates, Inc. for the March 26, 1983, trip and other trips which were cancelled.

In a separate Order of this Court, Attorneys for the State and for Defendants Beverly Earker, Merrill Cox, Robert Smith, and James Cody stipulated as to the accuracy of a list giving the names of persons who had paid EconoTouristic Associates, Inc. for travel or accommodations which they had not received and the amounts which they had paid and not been reimbursed from any source. At the trial of this matter, the attorney for Victor Barker and EconoTouristic Associates, Inc. joined in this stipulation of facts on behalf of his clients. This list is attached hereto and incorporated by reference as Attachment A.

The attorneys for the State and for Victor Barker and EconoTouristic Associates, Inc. also stipulated that Victor Barker had pled guilty to breach of trust with fraudulent intent for taking payments as President of EconoTouristic Associates, Inc. for trips for sixty-nine persons and for using the money for other purposes. While the State put

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into evidence depositions of the Defendants and several witnesses for the purpose of showing the details of how the allegations contained in its complaint actually occurred, the State's basic argument for civil penalties was based on Mr. Barker's conviction of sixty-nine counts of breach of trust. I agree that such evidence is sufficient for this Court to make its determination as to civil penalties.

I find that this Court has the power and duty to set a civil penalty of up to \$5,000 for each occurrence of a willful violation of an unfair trade practice and that the principal, (in this case EconoTouristic Associates, Inc.) and the agent, (in this case Victor Barker as President of EconoTouristic Associates, Inc.) are jointly and severally liable for such penalties as the intent of the agent is attributable to the principal. See <u>State ex rel. McLeod v.</u> <u>C & L Corp., Inc., et al</u>., 313 S.E.2d. 334 (SC App.1984). As the crime of breach of trust with fraudulent intent is obviously a willful unfair trade practice and as it is stipulated that there were at least sixty-nine instances of such violations in this case, I find that this Court could levy a civil penalty of up to \$345,000.

Considering the facts before the Court, I find that Victor Barker and EconoTouristic Associates, Inc. should be held jointly and severally liable for a civil penalty of \$175,000 in this case. I further find that the State is entitled to recover from Mr. Barker and EconoTouristic Associates, Inc. its costs in this case as outlined in the Affidavit attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Attachment B.

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I find that in view of the Consent Order dated August 20, 1984, signed by Judge Smith which allows restitution as requested by the State in this case and in view of the aforementioned findings of fact, I find that the monies of EconoTouristic Associates, Inc. held by the Clerk of Court pursuant to a prior Order in this case should be paid over to the Attorney General's Office to be used to make a <u>pro rata</u> distribution to those persons listed in Attachment A. I find that it is appropriate for this Court to order such restitution on its own motion under §39-5-50(b), CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA (1976) as well as under the equitable theory that these monies constitute a constructive trust held for the benefit of those persons who had paid money in trust to the corporation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Clerk of Court pay to the South Carolina Attorney General's Office all monies of EconoTouristic Associates, Inc. held by it and that Jet Charter, Inc. pay to the South Carolina Attorney General's Office the sum of \$5,000 with these monies to be used to make a <u>pro rata</u> distribution to those persons listed in Attachment A.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that judgment be entered in favor of the State against Victor D. Barker and EconoTouristic Associates, Inc. jointly and severally for civil penalties of \$175,000 and for costs of \$1,242.80 with interest at the legal rate from the day of this Order.
