## **Hiring: Short-Term Contract Authors for National Consumer Law Center Treatises**

The National Consumer Law Center® (NCLC®) is seeking attorneys with expertise in consumer law to contribute to our nationally recognized treatises on a contract basis. NCLC treatises are the definitive resources for practitioners, courts, and policymakers, covering every major area of consumer law.

We are seeking experienced practitioners who have worked directly on consumer protection issues, whether in a legal services, private, or government setting. Your knowledge and insight can help strengthen the tools that thousands of consumer advocates rely on to protect low-income borrowers across the country.

### **This role would involve:**

- Serving as an author or co-author to update individual treatise chapters or write new sections within an existing chapter
- Reviewing recent cases to be added to sections of the treatise
- Providing subject-matter expertise on emerging consumer law topics
- Adding practice tips and perspectives to round out our existing content

We estimate the time commitment to be roughly 40 hours over about a two-month time period. Although this is a limited engagement, we would take into account whether an applicant might be interested in updating the same chapter each year for several years, resources permitting.

At this time we are particularly interested in applicants with experience in debt collection, credit reporting, automobile fraud, criminal justice debt, credit card debt, mortgage servicing, and banking and payments law. However, we welcome applicants with other areas of consumer law experience as well.

## Who should consider applying:

- Attorneys with substantial experience in consumer protection litigation, regulation, or enforcement
- Practitioners with knowledge of federal and/or state consumer law.
- Legal scholars and practitioners committed to advancing consumer rights

## Why consider applying?

- Collaborate with NCLC's staff attorneys and other leading consumer law experts
- Shape the next generation of legal resources relied upon by advocates in the field

Contract authors work for NCLC on a temporary, part time basis as an independent contractor. Compensation is a flat rate per project based on the size of the project.
